BALLET

- ballet shoes
- hair must be in a bun
- tight fitting top or leotard
- tight fitting shorts, legging, or pants
- tights are not required
- no jewelry

CONTEMPORARY/JAZZ

- Comfortable clothes that allow for movement
- no shoes
- JAZZ
- hair must be tied back
- no jewelry

HIP HOP

- any clothes that allow free movement
- sneakers
- no jewelry

ACRO

- tight fitting athletic shorts, leggings or pants
- tight fitting top
- no shoes
- no jewelry
- hair must be back

TEAM REHEARSALS

All team members must wear **ALL BLACK** to team rehearsals. Clothes can be tight fitting or loose, but must be all black.

- no shoes for contemporary, jazz and musical theatre styles (socks are directors choice)
- sneakers for hip hop
